#### **HOW IT WORKS**

Graduate College of London is registered with the UK Register of Learning Providers (UKRLP), which is the portal for government departments, agencies, learners, and employers to share key information about learning providers. The UKRLP has been verified us and allocated a unique UK Provider Reference Number (UKPRN): 10063799. This is the unique identifier used to share information with the UKRLP partner agencies such as the Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA), the Higher Education Statistics Agency (HESA), the Office for Students (OfS) and UCAS.

You understand that you will begin a course of study online/ blended and able to complete the entire course to achieve a British degree certificate through online mood without traveling overseas. However, if you wish (optional) to continue Degree Top-Up programme in the UK directly at the campus, then you will be required to pay additional On-Campus Tuition Fee and provide additional evidence of your Academic and English ability to receive your Student Visa approval and meet further UK Immigration requirements. Students that require a student visa are required to provide a Secure English Language Test (SELT) or accepted equivalent. More information at: https://www.gov.uk/student-visa

Successful completion of your chosen course and meeting the entry requirements, you will be eligible to progress on to a degree top-up programme at the University. Progression pathways and degree courses offered at the University are subject to availability and change. Withdrawal or variation of any courses at will be in accordance with its policies and regulations. Some progression top-up degrees are offering fast-track option through Accreditation of Prior Experiential Learning (APEL) exemption process where credit is sought to complete within 6-month to 12-month duration plan. You will be able to select such option if applicable when applying for your top-up degrees programme. Certain courses may be subject to validation/re-validation/approval/re-approval/availability – please refer to our website for details. The course chosen course become unavailable for any reason a suitable alternative may be offered, subject to meeting the admission requirements for that programme. As places on some courses may be limited, you are advised to confirm or conditionally confirm as soon as possible.

For students who want to complete their degree through Graduate College of London (GCL International Study Campus) or directly at the University campus in the UK, we have arrangement with the following list of universities in the UK and overseas including USA and Australia. These provide direct entry to progression routes and subject disciplines from our Foundation and Diploma qualifications which enable students to develop the further study and career of their choice. Completion of our qualification will meet the university's standard academic entry requirements. However, each applicant will be subject to individual assessment and other entry requirements.

qualifications are divided into Higher Education qualifications, which are on the Framework for Higher Education Qualifications (FHEQ) and are awarded by bodies with degree awarding powers, and Regulated qualifications, which are on the Regulated Qualifications Framework (RQF) and are accredited by Ofqual in England, the Council for the Curriculum, Examinations and Assessment in Northern Ireland and Qualifications Wales in Wales. In Scotland, qualifications are divided into Higher Education qualifications, Scottish Qualifications Authority qualifications and Scottish Vocational Qualifications/Modern Apprenticeships, which are on the Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework (SCQF). Scottish Higher Education Qualifications are on both the SCQF and the FHEQ.





### **Bachelors Entry Requirements**

#### Learner must possess:

 Relevant NQF/QCF/RQF Level 3 Award/Diploma or at the level of GCE/GCSE or Secondary education/ high school or any equivalent qualification.

OR

- ✓ Work experience of 2 years or more in case you do not hold any formal qualification and
- ✓ Learner must be 18 years or older at the beginning of the course.

### **Masters Entry Requirements**

#### The Learners must possess:

- ✓ Level 6 Award/Diploma or a bachelor's degree or any other equivalent qualification OR
- √ 5 years or more of work experience in case you do not hold any formal qualification and
- ✓ Learner must be 18 years or older at the beginning of the course.

### **Research Entry Requirements**

#### The Learners must possess:

- ✓ A recognised master's degree in a subject related to the programme with a cumulative grade point average of greater than 3.0 on a 4.0-point scale or its equivalent.
- ✓ A recognised bachelor's degree in a subject related to the programme.
- $\checkmark$  At least the master's or the bachelor's degree should be in related subject.
- ✓ At least the master's or the bachelor's degree should be in related subject.
- ✓ A minimum SAT score of 1550, TOEFL score of 580 (237 CBT, 92 iBT), IELTS academic score of 6.5 (6.0 on writing section), or their equivalents on another standardised nationally, or internationally, recognised test that is approved by the Ministry of Education.
- ✓ The chosen area of study must be one, which can be supervised by staff within the University.
- ✓ An initial proposal for research, including motivation to study for a PhD, which will be discussed through an interview.
- ✓ Submission of a certificate of equivalency issued by the Ministry of Education for all previous degree certificates awarded by institutions outside the UK.
- ✓ A copy of the passport along with a copy of the ID (If available).
